

PUTNAM COUNTY NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Putnam County is submitting a modification to its Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 (NSP3) Application. The County is revising its budget as noted below. One hundred percent (100%) of the County's NSP3 funds will continue to benefit households with incomes at or below 120% Area Median Income (AMI). At least twenty-five percent (25%) of NSP3 funds will continue to benefit fifty percent (50%) AMI households.
