The second portion was completed and a festival/grand opening was held on August 17, 2013. FDOT is working to obtain enhancement funding for the right-of-way along the first portion.
Palatka to Lake Butler	St. Augustine to Lake City Rail Trail	Don Jacobovitz	The first segment from Clay County to CR 315 was completed. FDOT has a project underway to fix a portion of that trail. Construction on the second segment, from Grandin to QI Roberts Middle School, is completed. For the next segment to Roberts Lane, FDOT has let the contract and construction began in spring 2013. The final segment to SJRWMD's office has funding in fiscal year 2015 for design but the construction is not funded. Putnam County has received a grant to develop a trailhead in Florahome. The design and engineering process is underway for the paved connection from the trail to the restroom at the trailhead using pervious material. A parking area has been added at Holloway Road close to the trail segment's connection.
