



**FOR CURBSIDE PICKUP**

- ◆ PUT TRASH AND RECYCLING AT CURB BY 6 AM
- ◆ PUT THE TRASH IN A CAN WITH A LID THAT FITS
- ◆ CAN BE NO LARGER THAN 33 GALLONS WITH TWO HANDLES—NOT TO EXCEED 50 LBS.
- ◆ CARPET MUST BE CUT INTO LENGTHS NO LARGER THAN 6 FT.
- ◆ DO NOT PLACE CLOSE TO MAILBOX

**YARD WASTE**

- ◆ PUT THE YARD CUTTINGS OUT ONLY ON THEIR DESIGNATED DAY
- ◆ BRUSH MUST BE 4 FT OR LESS AND PLACED IN BUNDLES
- ◆ CLIPPINGS AND LEAVES MAY BE PLACED IN 32 GALLON CANS OR 40 LB CAPACITY
- ◆ LARGE LIMBS SHOULD BE CUT INTO LENGTHS NO GREATER THAN 6FT
- ◆ DO NOT PUT TREE REMOVAL AT CURB

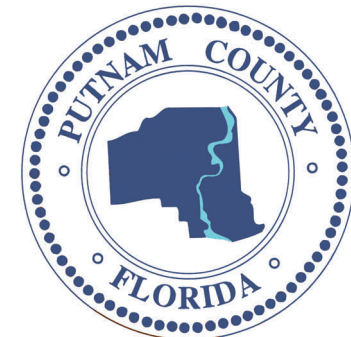

**OUR MISSION**

To change the attitudes of all the citizens of Putnam County toward the disposal of waste through education and motivation with the emphasis placed on youth education.

**Great American Clean Up**

Held each year from March 1-May 30; volunteers from communities across the nation rally to fight dirty streets, waterways and public spaces by removing litter and illegal dumpsites, greening up parks, school yards and other public places, hosting educational events, painting out graffiti and more.

**Neighborhood/Community Cleanups**

Local groups or individuals may call to schedule a neighborhood or community cleanup project. KPB will provide the necessary tools for the volunteers, such as trash bags, grabbers and safety vests.

**Litter Prevention Community Presentations**

Keep Putnam Beautiful participates in many school-based and community events to educate the public and its youth about litter prevention and to encourage recycling activities.

**International/Florida Coastal Cleanup**

Each year, on the third Saturday in September, teams of energetic volunteers descend on beaches, lakes, rivers and streams all over the world to clean up trash and debris on land and in water. They are united in the world's largest volunteer event on behalf of clean waterways and a clean oceans.

**Adopt-A-Highway & Adopt-A-Road Programs**

Encourages volunteers to adopt a section of a state highway or county road within our community, with cleanups at least four times annually, including the Great American Cleanup and Florida Coastal Cleanup. This gives the public a sense of community pride and awareness of the importance of litter prevention.

**Beautification Projects**

Local parks and public areas are targeted with cleanup activities, landscaping, weeding and other improvements.

The 1994 Standard Housing Code requires the following:

- ◆ Proper disposal of trash and debris.
- ◆ Proper disposal of old appliances, furniture and materials.
- ◆ Proper disposal of inoperable cars, trucks, RV's, ATV's, etc.
- ◆ Maintenance of grass, weeds and dead trees.
- ◆ Safe and sanitary dwellings.

**Littering is a Crime**

Littering is a misdemeanor according to Florida Statute 403.413

Any person who dumps litter from a motor vehicle, boat, or on private property without the landowners consent is in violation of the Florida Litter Law.

**NOTE:** On private property, even with the landowners consent the items dumped must not be a public nuisance, or be in violation of any state or local laws, rules or regulations.
