Commercial customers will be charged \$34.00 per ton for the disposal of waste.

Tires will be charged \$210.00 per ton.

Special Handling will be charged at \$100.00 per ton.

Things to know

- Driver's License or Photo ID is required for everyone using the Putnam County Central Landfill, Interlachen Convenience Center, or Huntington Convenience Center.
- Proof of residency is required to dump. Examples of acceptable verification would be current annual tax bill, driver's license or photo ID that lists correct address, utility bill, rental or lease agreement (renters).
- Households that have been assessed the special assessment (located on annual tax bill as Solid Waste Fee) will be allowed to utilize allotments for C&D Debris (2000 lbs per year) and Residential Yard Trash (4000 lbs per year). After allotment is reached standard charges apply. (See Tree Debris & Fees in brochure)
- Third Party Haulers in order for a third party hauler to bring debris into the Landfill and utilize another person's allotment a "Third Party Hauler Form" must be completed IN ADVANCE for the hauler to use the other person's allotment. The form must be completed in its entirety, there are no exceptions to this rule.

<u>Tires</u>

• <u>Residents only</u> may bring in five (5) car or light truck tires per year at no charge. After the allowed five (5) tires at no charge, standard charges will apply. (See **Fees** in brochure)

> <u>NOTE:</u> Clean tires only in the tire pit area.

E – Waste (Electronic Waste)

 Located at the front entrance to the Central Landfill. All E-Waste is to be stacked on the provided pallet at the front gate/entrance. We do accept TV's and computer monitors, ONLY the FLAT SCREEN TYPE. ONLY old box style TV's are permitted to be dumped in the Landfill. We now have E-Waste containers at our Huntington & Interlachen facilities also.

Tree Debris

- **Residential Yard Waste** greater than 4" in diameter and longer than 6' in length is **not** covered in the Assessment; therefore, is charged to the resident (after annual allotment has been met).
- Only <u>yard/tree</u> debris in the yard/tree debris pile. If you have bagged leaves you must dump the leaves out of the plastic bags and place the bags in the dumpster on your way out.

Construction & Demolition Debris

 Is not covered in the Assessment; therefore, is charged to both residential (after allotment has been met) and commercial loads.

Metal/Steel

- **ONLY** steel or white goods are permitted in the metal/steel pile. The item being dumped has to be at least 90% metal. If it does not meet this criteria it has to go into the Landfill.
- Examples of White Goods: Refrigerator, Freezer, Washer, Dryer, Dishwasher, Hot Water Heater, Microwave, A/C Units.

Recyclables

Not allowed in the LANDFILL AREA, but can be recycled at our facilities: Vehicle Batteries White Goods Used Motor Oil Tires E-Waste Gas (see limit of acceptance) Florescent Bulbs (see limit of acceptance) Household Hazardous Waste (see limit of acceptance)
