Letter from the Director

We are honored to contribute our services to over 70,000 residents of Putnam County plus those that visit our county for special events. We would like to sincerely thank all of our recreation program participants and park patrons. The following is a list of projects and opportunities that were met during the fiscal year 2019-20.

- The long-awaited restoration of the Project PLAY playground was completed with an array of amenities sure to please everyone. There is an ADA accessible rubber sidewalk, separate playground features for children of different ages as well as different abilities. This effort was a culmination of the partnership we have with the Rotary Club of Palatka and the generous donation they provided.
- The County received its first ever splash pad, located at Project PLAY, directly next to the new playground. The splash pad will be open during months that temperatures will support patrons using it.
- As with most other organizations, both private and public, we modified our offerings to the public this last year. A lot of programs were cancelled or severely modified. We offered a modified soccer season by the end of October, and were able to have one of our "Movie in the Park" Events.
- We offered a fun and alternative program that we titled, "Rec-It Bags." This provided bags to 450 families that had not been able to participate in other activities. Each of these bags had various items for play and learning for multiple age groups within a family.

We appreciate the community's support during these difficult times. We got through this, as we do with most other hardships we face, together and as a team. We hope to be able to have more programs and activities to offer to the community this year. Lesson Descriptions

Parent & Child: Parents are taught to safely work with their children in the water as they are taught skills to prepare them to learn to swim. Parent participation is required. Ages 6 months - 4 years

Level 1: Intro to Water Skills Participants learn to safely enter and exit water, make progress through the water using arms & legs, float and recover.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills Children perform Level 1 skills, swimming several body lengths without instructor support.

Level 3: Stroke Development Children learn the front crawl and elementary backstroke, swimming each 15 yards and are introduced to the scissors & dolphin kicks and treading water.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement Swimmers practice front crawl and backstroke and are introduced to side stroke, back crawl, breast stroke, butterfly and turning at the wall.

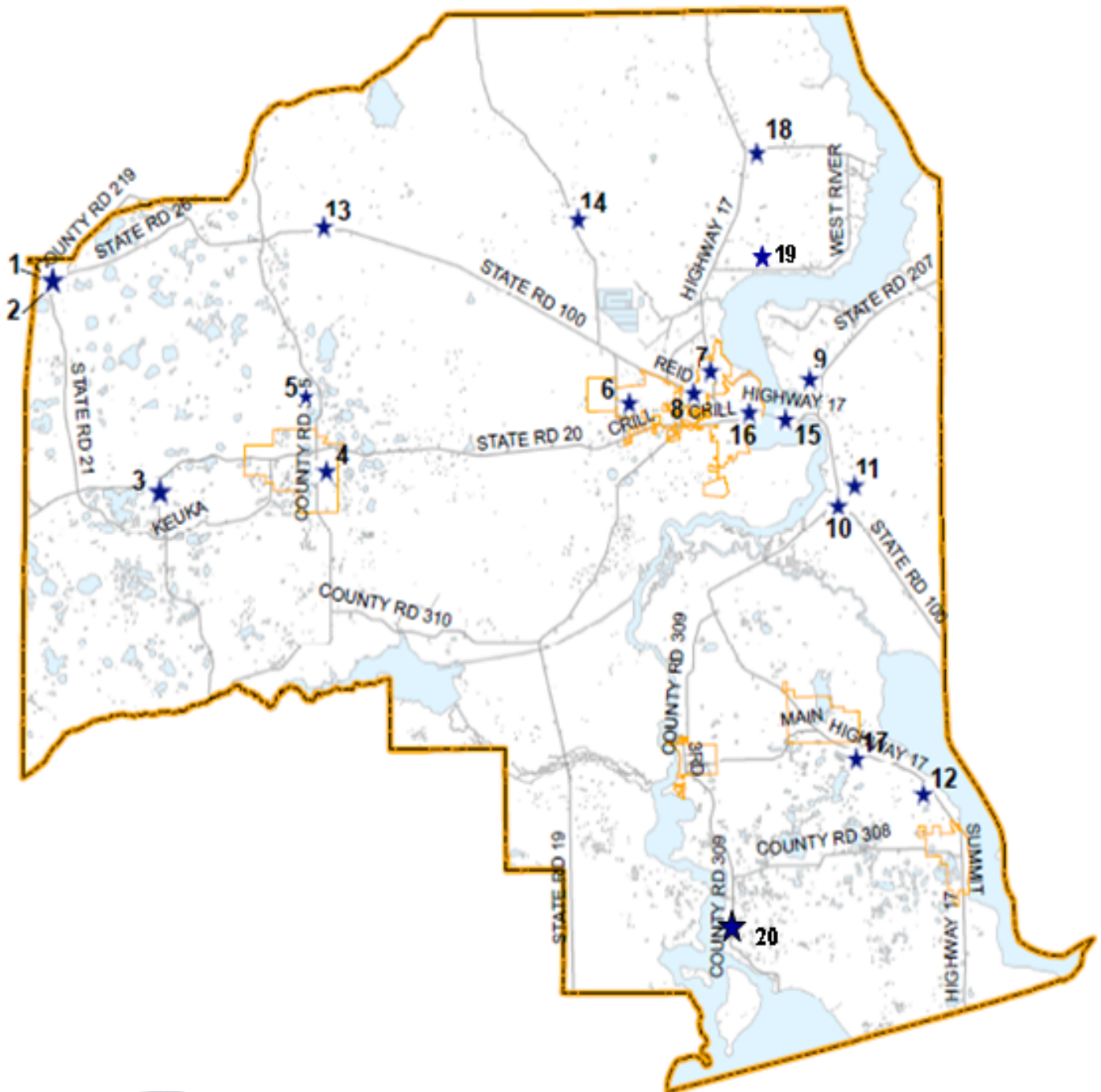
The club focuses on improving competitive swimming abilities, teaching and improving form, and instilling good sportsmanship behaviors.
