LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR

Welcome to the Putnam County Parks and Recreation Department. We are honored to contribute our services to over 70,000 residents of Putnam County as well as those that visit our county for special events. We would like to sincerely thank all of our recreation program participants and park patrons. The following is a list of projects and opportunities that were met during fiscal year 2021-22.

The County had partnered with the Florahome Parks Association for the rehabilitation of a previously used building at the Florahome Park Property. This building was known as Palmetto Hall and has a very rich history in the community. This partnership has allowed the almost complete restoration of this facility.

The St. Johns River Pickleball Group had received an allotment of \$100,000 to construct new permanent pickleball courts at the John Theobold Sports Complex. By this writing, that project should be complete and the pickleball group will have brand new courts to play on. The Board of County Commissioners has set aside \$40,000 for the department to have a well dug on site for the Project Play splash pad. That project should also be completed by the delivery of this guide.

We enjoyed a much higher success rate this year with our volunteers for our sports and activities as well as for our officials that are needed to ensure a successful program for our sports activities. As our mission statement states, we always strive to improve the programs we currently offer as well as try to offer new activities and programs to the community. We want to be able to successfully serve as many citizens of the community as our resources will allow.














2022 YEAR IN REVIEW



Winter T-Ball

The Parks & Recreation Department hosted its annual winter program of T-Ball late January - early March. This year the t-ball program located in the Palatka area hosted approximately 60 players, coaches, and officials. Practices were held at John Theobold Sports Complex throughout the week, and games were on Saturday mornings starting at 9am. The program is for youth ages 4-6 and is designed as an introduction to the game of baseball/softball, where FUNdamentals are the main focus!

Winter Adult Softball

Our Winter Adult Softball league coincided with our T-Ball season this year. We had 8 teams that played games on Monday nights at John Theobold Sports Complex fields 1-4. JTSC Fields 1-4 are also used during these months by organizations throughout the county for fastpitch and slowpitch practice, games, and tournaments.

Spring Flag Football

The Parks & Recreation Department hosted its annual Spring Program of Flag Football April- May. This year the Flag Football program had 12 teams with approximately 150 players. The program is for youth ages 4-6, 7-9, & 10-12. Practices for this program were held at John Theobold Sports Complex throughout the week, and games were on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

South Putnam

The Parks & Recreation Department - South Putnam extension hosted it's annual Spring Program of Flag Football April- May. The Flag Football program had 100 players throughout the the age groups of 4-6, 7-9, & 10-12. All practices and games were held throughout the week at South Putnam Sports Complex in Crescent City.

Spring Sand Volleyball

The Parks & Recreation Department hosted its annual Spring Program of Sand Volleyball April- May. The Sand Volleyball program had approximately 70 players ages 8-14. Practices for were held at John Theobold Sports Complex throughout the week, and games were on Tuesday evenings.

Spring Indoor Volleyball South Putnam

The Parks & Recreation Department - South Putnam extension hosted it's annual Spring Program of Indoor Volleyball April- May . The Volleyball program had approximately 140 players consisting of three age groups: 7-9, 10-12, & 13-15. All practices and games were held throughout the week at South Putnam Sports Complex in Crescent City.

Summer Aquatics


The Putnam Aquatics Center had a successful 2022 season! The center provided 184 children with swim lessons and the knowledge of water safety skills. The facility reached new records with 25 water aerobic members & 46 lap swim members. Almost 400 members of Putnam County attended daily community swim fun! The ARC community of Putnam County brought joy to the staff and friends with their presence every Friday morning. We are also home to the Putnam Sharks Swim Club & the Palatka High Swim Team.

Fall Soccer

The Parks & Recreation Department hosted its annual fall program of soccer this October & November. This year the soccer program located in the Palatka area had 293 kids register to play with 42 volunteer coaches, and 13 referees. The program is broken down into 3 major age groups; 4-6, 7-9 and 10-12 with designated field space and design for each age group. The goal of this program is to help the youth participants learn the basics and fundamentals of the sport of soccer at an affordable price. All games and practices are held at John Theobold Sports Complex throughout the week, with games on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursday nights at 6pm.

Fall Soccer South Putnam

The South Putnam Soccer season coincides with our soccer season as an extension of the department into the Crescent City area. Our South Putnam team is led by Judy Jackson who manages the entirety of the program. This year, the program had almost 200 participants with 31 volunteer coaches and 12 referees. For sake of continuity, the age groups and dates are the same. All games and practices are held at South Putnam Youth Sports Complex throughout the week.



LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Parent & Child: Parents are taught to safely work with their children in the water as they are taught skills to prepare them to learn to swim. Parent participation is required. Ages 6 months - 4 years.

Level 1: Intro to Water Skills. Participants learn to safely enter and exit water, make progress through the water using arms & legs, float and recover.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills. Children perform Level 1 skills, swimming several body lengths without instructor support.


Level 3: Stroke Development. Children learn the front crawl and elementary backstroke, swimming each 15 yards and are introduced to the scissors & dolphin kicks and treading water.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement. Swimmers practice front crawl and backstroke and are introduced to side stroke, back crawl, breast stroke, butterfly and turning at the wall.



The Putnam Sharks Swim Club is open to all swimmers ages 5-18 and is a mix between a competitive and a recreational sports club. The primary competitive season is Summer (May-July), proceeded and followed by the training/conditioning seasons of Spring (February-April) and Fall (August - November).

The club focuses on improving competitive swimming abilities, teaching and improving form, and instilling good sportsmanship behaviors.





